LISTING OF MATTERS IN THE CHILDREN'S KOORI COURT (CRIMINAL DIVISION) AT MELBOURNE

This Practice Direction is issued pursuant to section 592 of the *Children, Youth and Families Act 2005.*

Preamble

The Koori Court (Criminal Division) is established under s.517 of the *Children*, *Youth and Families Act 2005* (the Act). The Children's Koori Court has jurisdiction under s.518, s.518A and s.519 of the Act to deal with a proceeding for:

- (a) an offence (other than a sexual offence); or
- (b) breach of a sentence, where the Aboriginal child consents to the proceeding being dealt with by the Children's Koori Court and the child
 - (i) intends to plead guilty to the offence; or
 - (ii) pleads guilty to the offence; or
 - (iii) has been found guilty of the offence by the Criminal Division.

This Practice Direction aims to ensure that matters adjourned to the Children's Koori Court at Melbourne are in a position to proceed as either a plea of guilty or, where appropriate, for diversion to be considered pursuant to s.59 of the *Criminal Procedure Act* and s.528 of the Act.

Directions

- 1. This Practice Direction applies to all matters that are eligible to proceed in the Children's Koori Court at Melbourne.
- 2. For a matter to be adjourned to the Children's Koori Court at Melbourne, the attached Children's Koori Court Certificate of Readiness must be completed and signed by the child's legal representative and the prosecution. The agreed summaries of the charges must be attached to the Certificate of Readiness. Upon filing the certificate and summaries with the registry the matter will be listed on the next available Children's Koori Court hearing date.

3. For a matter to be adjourned from another court to the Children's Koori Court at Melbourne, the Certificate of Readiness and agreed summaries must be filed at the registry of the other court and the Children's Koori Court hearing date will be obtained from the Melbourne Children's Court coordinator.

This Practice Direction commences on 1 July 2016.
