<u>Purpose:</u> To encourage consistency of practice in the application of the *Children and Young Persons Act 1989*.

In any matter in the Family Division of the Court where a party to a proceeding (who is not a child) is not present in Court at the time of the making of

- a. a protection order,
- b an interim protection order,
- c an extension and/or variation of a custody to secretary order,
- d. an extension of a guardianship order, or
- e. a permanent care order
