PROVISION OF WITNESS LISTS IN FAMILY DIVISION

This Practice Direction is issued pursuant to Section 280D of the *Children and Young Persons Act 1989*

<u>Purpose</u>: To assist in the proper estimates of length and co-ordination of contested hearings in the Family Division, in all matters that proceed to a Directions Hearing, **except with the leave** of the Court, each party must file a witness list

A <u>witness list</u> must contain a list of witnesses each party proposes to call including identifying details of any documents made or reports prepared by that witness upon which that party intends to rely.
