## INTERSTATE TRANSFER OF CHILD PROTECTION ORDERS

This practice direction is issued pursuant to Section 280D of the Children and Young Persons Act 1989.

Purpose:

To centralise the process of registering child protection orders transferred to Victoria from another state or territory of Australia or from New Zealand

A copy of any child protection order transferred to Victoria under an interstate law ( which includes a law of an Australian territory and New Zealand) together with all other appropriate documentation must be filed for registration by the Secretary of the Department of Human Services (Vic) at the Melbourne venue of the Children's Court of Victoria
