1		VISITS & COOPERATION must accept visits from and cooperate with DFFH.
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2		SUPPORT SERVICES must accept support services as <i>[directed by/agreed with]</i> DFFH.
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3		COUNSELLING must go to counselling as <i>[directed by/agreed with]</i> DFFH and must allow reports <i>[about attendance]</i> to be given to DFFH.
4		FAMILY VIOLENCE COUNSELLING must go to family violence counselling as <i>[directed by/agreed with]</i> DFFH and must allow reports <i>[about attendance]</i> to be given to DFFH.
5		ANGER MANAGEMENT must go to a course on anger management as <i>[directed by/agreed with]</i> DFFH and must allow reports <i>[about attendance]</i> to be given to DFFH.
6		PSYCH ASSESSMENT AND/OR TREATMENT must go to a <i>[psychologist, psychiatrist, psychologist and/or psychiatrist]</i> as <i>[directed by/agreed with]</i> DFFH for <i>[assessment, treatment, assessment and treatment]</i> and must allow reports to be given to DFFH.
7		PAEDIATRIC ASSESSMENT & TREATMENT must <i>[take the child/allow the child to be taken]</i> to a paediatrician for assessment, must allow any recommended treatment to be carried out and must allow reports to be given to DFFH.
8		ALCOHOL/DRUG TESTING must submit to random supervised <i>[alcohol, drug, alcohol and drug]</i> testing [<input type="checkbox"/>] <i>times per week</i> or otherwise as directed by DFFH and must allow the results to be given to DFFH.
9		must submit to testing for <i>[alcohol, drug, alcohol and drug]</i> use as directed by DFFH and must allow the results to be given to DFFH.
11		ALCOHOL/DRUG ASSESSMENT/TREATMENT must participate in assessment and/or treatment for <i>[alcohol, drug, alcohol and drug]</i> dependence as directed by DFFH and must allow reports to be given to DFFH.
12		ABSTINENCE must not <i>[drink alcohol, drink alcohol to excess, use illegal drugs, drink alcohol or use illegal drugs, drink alcohol to excess or use illegal drugs]</i> .
13		must not drink alcohol or use illegal drugs when with the child and must not be affected by alcohol or illegal drugs when with the child.
14		ACCOMMODATION may have respite as agreed between
15		must <i>[make best endeavour to]</i> find a suitable home.
16		must live where DFFH directs.
17		must live with
18		CHANGE OF ADDRESS must tell DFFH <i>[at least 24 hours before/within 24 hours of]</i> changing address.
19		CURFEW The child must not be away from home/placement between unless the child's parent or caregiver agrees.
20		NO COHABITATION must not live or have contact with the <i>[mother and, father and]</i> child <i>[other than Court-ordered contact]</i> .
21		NO CONTACT must not have any contact with the child.

22		EXPOSING CHILD TO VIOLENCE must not expose the child to physical or verbal violence.
23		NO PHYSICAL DISCIPLINE must not hit or hurt the child for any reason.
24		NO THREATS/ASSAULTS must not threaten or assault DFFH staff.
25		CHILD'S HEALTH must take the child to the Maternal and Child Health Nurse as often as the nurse recommends.
26		must take the child to the doctor for regular check-ups as required by DFFH or the doctor and must allow reports to be given to DFFH.
27	The child must go to school every school day unless the child is ill <i>[and a medical certificate is obtained]</i> .	SCHOOL
28		must send the child to school every school day unless the child is ill <i>[and a medical certificate is obtained]</i> .
29		LIBERTY TO APPLY has/have the right to come to Court and ask the Court to change the order.
30		CHILDREN'S COURT CLINIC must go to the Children's Court Clinic for an assessment.
31		THE CHILD'S RIGHT TO CONTACT may have contact with the child <i>[for a minimum of</i> <i>]</i> at times and places as agreed between
