

## PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 14 of 2021

This Practice Direction is issued pursuant to section 592 of the *Children, Youth and Families Act* 2005 (the Act) from 27 November 2021 until:

- 30 January 2022, in respect of paragraphs 2 to 6;
- 5 February 2022, in respect of paragraph 7; and
- 5 March 2022, in respect of paragraph 8 (the relevant periods).
- 1. The Online Children's Court (the OCC) will continue to hear matters across all Divisions of the Court during the relevant periods.

## Practice Direction No. 2 of 2021

- 2. Paragraphs 11, 13 18, 25 and 36 of Practice Direction No. 2 of 2021 are suspended.
- 3. Where a child is not on remand and is represented by a legal practitioner, the legal practitioner must arrange with the relevant Court for the matter to be listed in the OCC.
- 4. To list a matter in the OCC, contact should be made with the relevant Court Registry (see <u>local</u> <u>court registry</u>) **by email not later than 3 clear working days** prior to the current listing date, for the purpose of obtaining a hearing time.
- 5. Where a child is not legally represented and has not otherwise arranged for their matter to proceed in the OCC, their matter(s) will be adjourned to the next available return date and a hearing notice will be sent to the child.
- 6. To avoid unnecessary adjournments, the Court directs the parties to conduct a summary case conference pursuant to s54(3) of the *Criminal Procedure Act* 2009 prior to the mention date.

## Practice Direction No. 3 of 2021

7. Paragraphs 16 and 17 of Practice Direction No. 3 of 2021 are suspended and those hearings will otherwise be listed to be heard in the OCC. If a party cannot participate via the OCC they may appear via telephone or in person if urgent and in accordance with paragraph 2. Where a matter is listed for a second or subsequent hearing and not able to be heard in the OCC or via telephone, it will be adjourned to the next available return date.

## Practice Direction No. 6 of 2021

8. Paragraph 13, parts h) to j) of Practice Direction No. 6 of 2021 are suspended and those hearings will otherwise be listed to be heard in the OCC.

This Practice Direction commences on 27 November 2021.
