<b>JB</b>	Older child of the mother. Is the subject of a permanent care order and is in the care of the maternal grandmother and Mr M.
<b>Mr &amp; Mrs B</b>	The maternal uncle and his wife with whom SD has resided since he was 4 days old.
<b>B</b>	Child of Mrs B - in the care of Mr & Mrs B
<b>T</b>	Child of Mrs B - in the care of Mr & Mrs B
<b>J</b>	Child of Mr & Mrs B - in the care of Mr & Mrs B
<b>N</b>	Child of Mr & Mrs B - in the care of Mr & Mrs B
<b>Ms CC</b>	DOHS Child Protection team leader. Not called as a witness.

<b>Ms TB</b>	DOHS specialist infant protective worker. Not called as a witness.
<b>Ms CH</b>	DOHS worker. Not called as a witness.
<b>Dr DE</b>	Paediatrician, Royal Children's Hospital. Not called as a witness.
